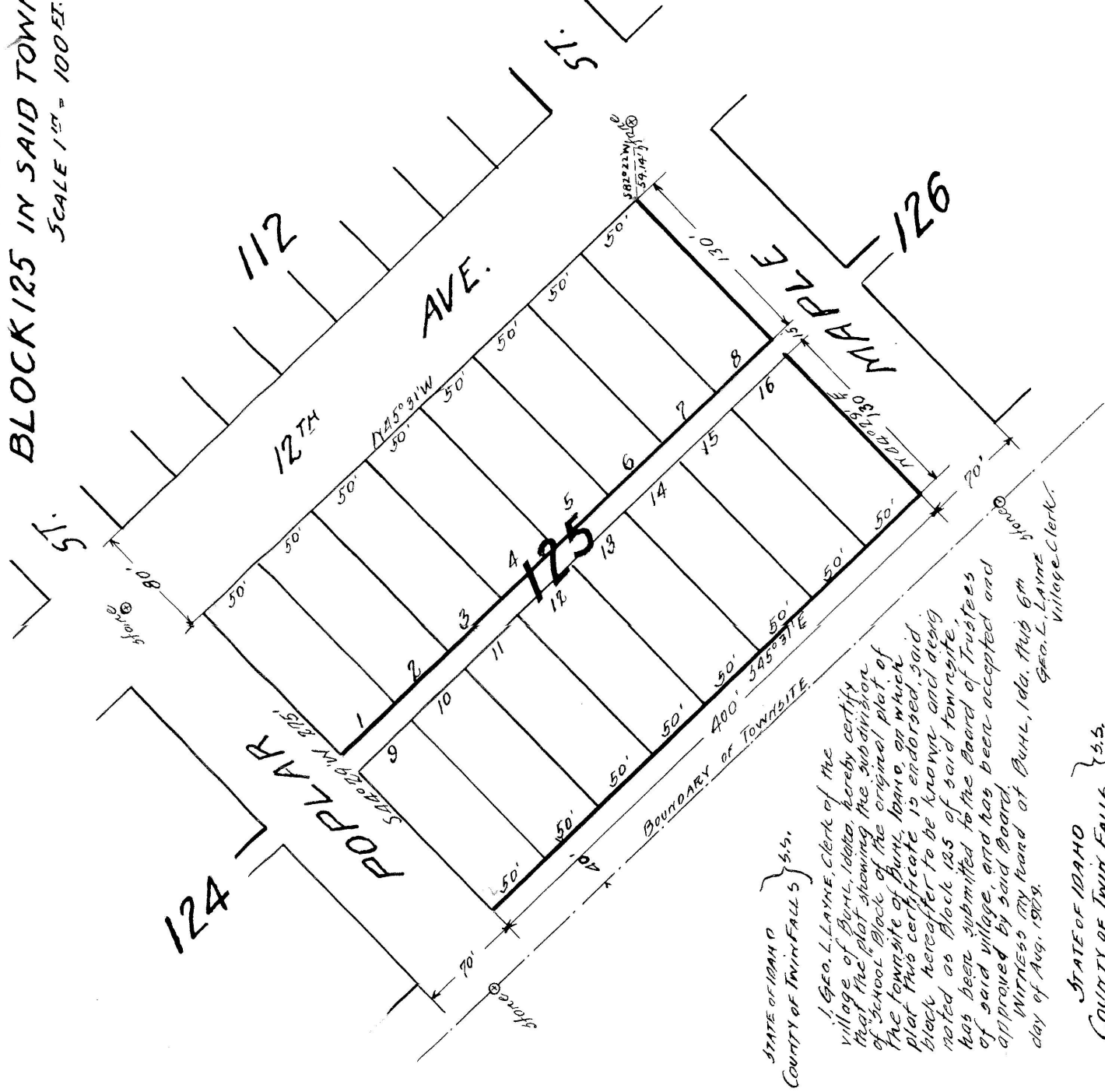


BUHL TOWNSITE CO'S PLAT AND SUBDIVISION
THE TRACT DESIGNATED AS "SCHOOL" BLOCK.

ORIGINAL TOWNSITE OF BUHL, IDAHO
TO BE KNOWN AS
BLOCK 125 IN SAID TOWNSITE

I, JAMES A. BYBEE, a duly licensed and authorized surveyor, do hereby certify that I have made a survey of that portion of the townsite of Buhl, Idaho, which is designated on the official plat thereof as "School" block, and which would correspond to Block 125 in said townsite, the same being bounded as follows, to-wit:— On the Southeast by Maple Street, on the Northeast by Twelfth Street, on the Northwest by Poplar Street and on the Southwest by a vacant strip, lying between said block and the southwest boundary of said townsite, and that said tract of land so surveyed is correctly described as follows, to-wit:—

Beginning at a stone at the intersection of the center lines of 12th Ave and Maple St. thence S82°22'W 53.14 ft to the East corner of said tract, thence N45°31'W 400 ft to the North corner, thence S45°31'W 275 ft to the West corner, thence S45°31'W 400 ft to the South corner, thence N45°31'E 275 ft to the place of beginning.

It is further certified that stone monuments have been planted six inches under the ground at the intersections of the center lines of the streets bounding the said tract of land so surveyed, containing at least 500 cu. in., and the exact points where the same are located are marked on the plat of said ground which accompanies this certificate, and that stakes of least two inches square and fourteen inches in length and driven at least ten inches in the ground, have been placed at each and every corner of each and every lot on said tract of ground.

It is further certified that the plat which accompanies this certificate is a correct plat and description of the land included in said survey.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the Buhl Townsite Co., a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Idaho, and duly authorized to do business in the State of Idaho, does hereby certify that the plat which accompanies this certificate contains a correct description of the land included in the plat of the tract of ground shown on the original plat of the townsite of Buhl, Idaho, as "SCHOOL" block, and which is now designated as Block No. 125. Said description being as follows, to-wit:— Beginning at a stone at the intersection of the center lines of 12th Ave and Maple St. thence S82°22'W 53.14 ft to the East corner of said tract, thence N45°31'W 400 ft to the North corner, thence S45°31'W 275 ft to the West corner, thence S45°31'W 400 ft to the South corner, thence N45°31'E 275 ft to the place of beginning.

And said corporation does hereby further state that it is its intention to include said land in the plat of the townsite of Buhl, Idaho, and that the same hereafter known and designated as Block No. 125 in said townsite, and that the same shall be subdivided into lots as shown on the face thereof, and it is further declared that in consideration of the filing of said plat and the acceptance by the public of the streets and alleys, shown thereon, the Buhl Townsite Co. does hereby give grant and convey to the public such portions of the premises so plotted as are on said plat set apart for streets, alleys, and public grounds for public use.
