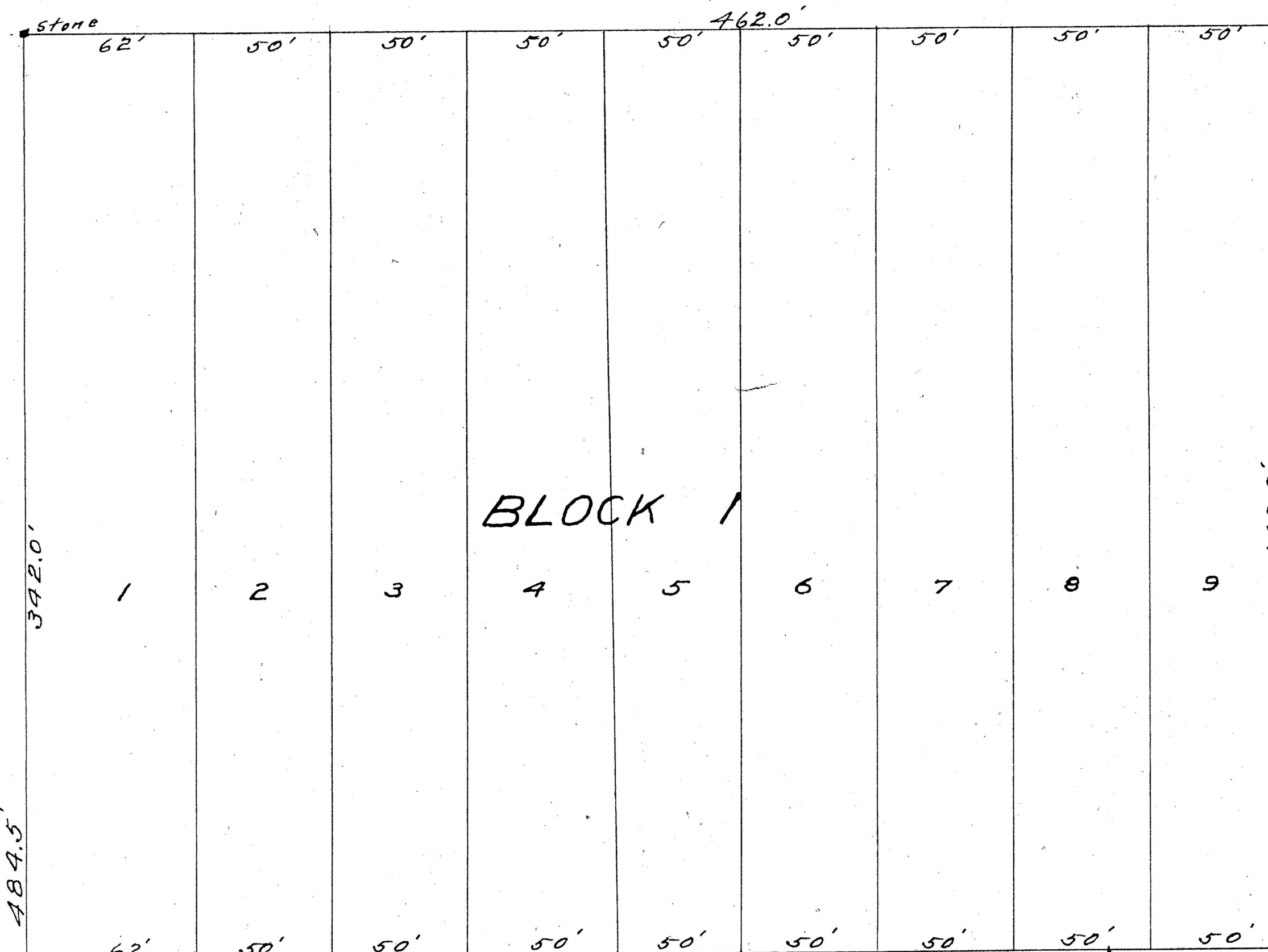


DILLON SUBDIVISION

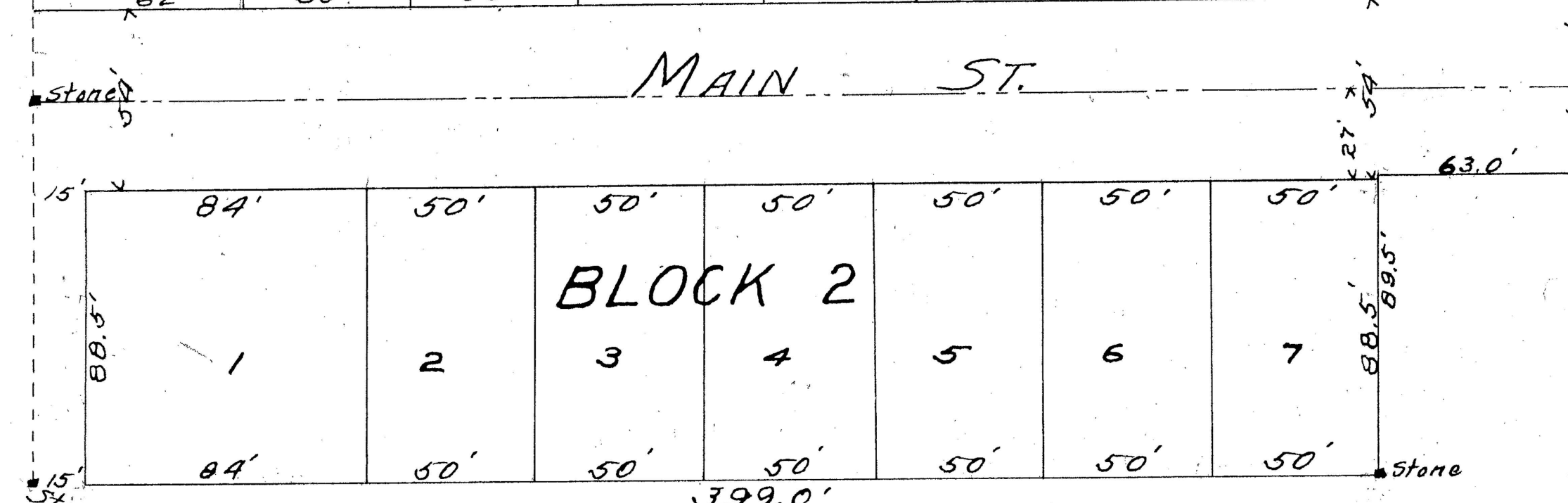
