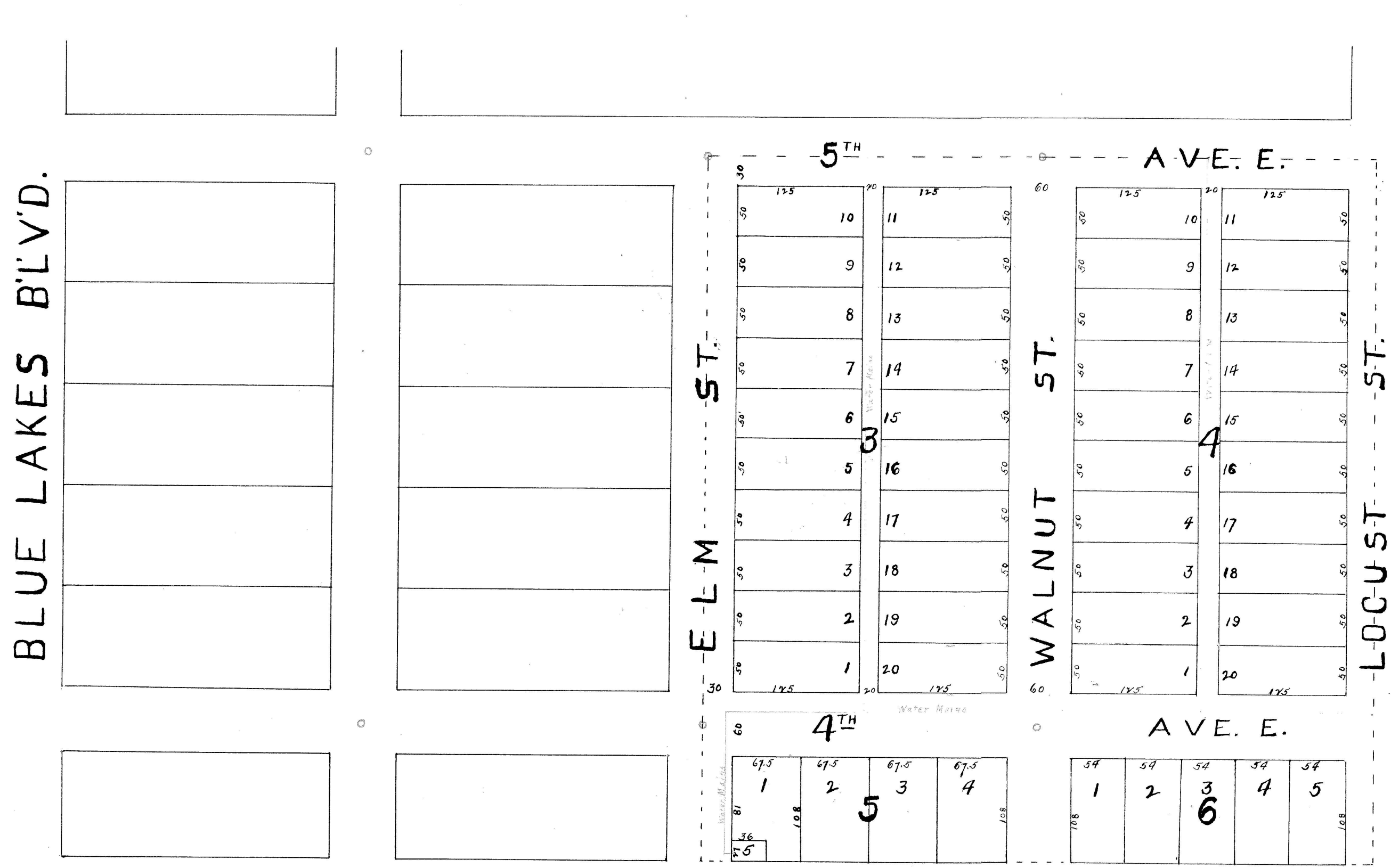
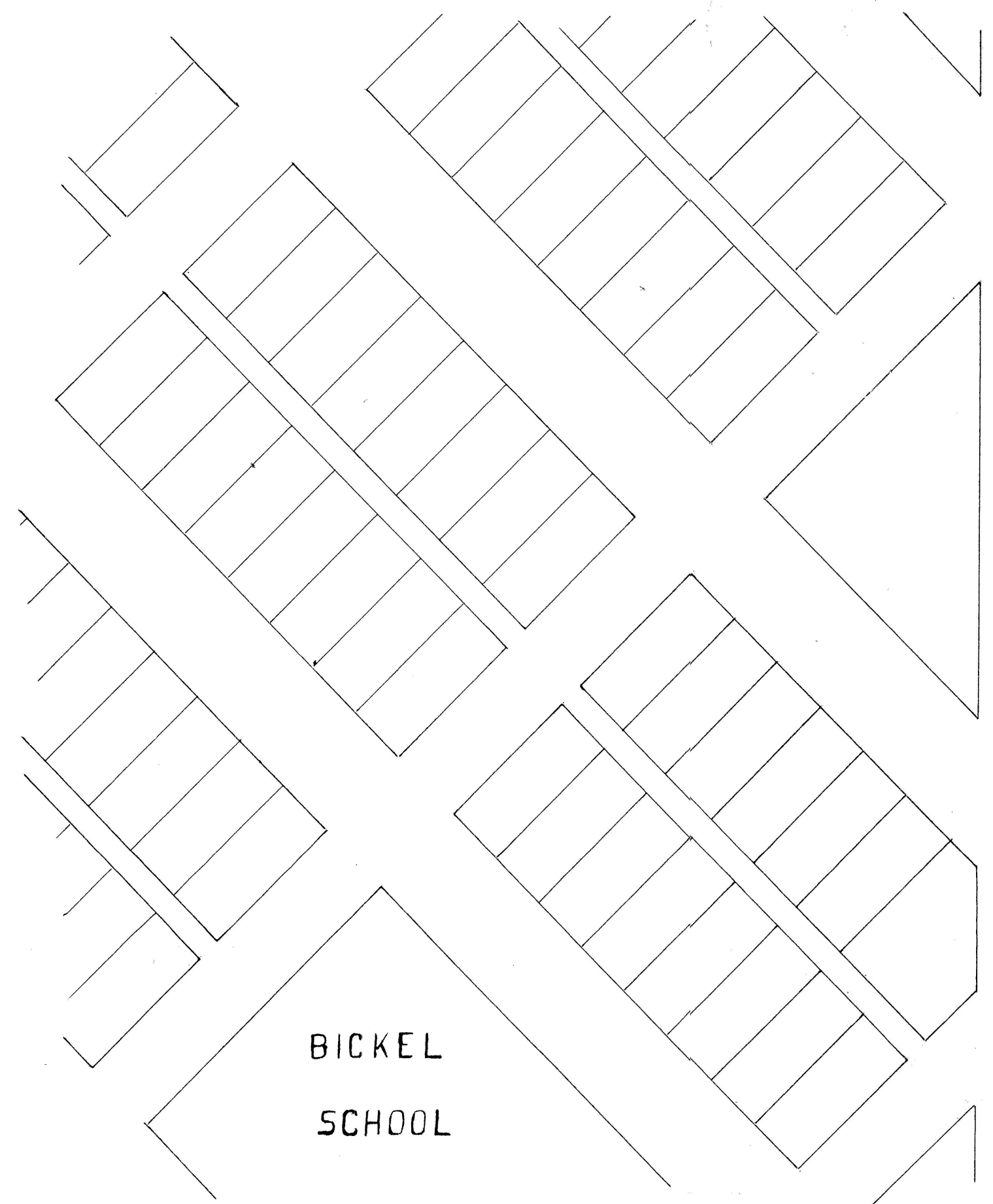

Know ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Edwin W. Davis of Twin Falls, Idaho, do hereby certify that the following is a correct description of the land included in the plat of Elm Park Addition to the City of Twin Falls, which is included herewith. Said lands being known and described as being a part of Section 15 T. 10 S. R. 17 E. B. M. and more particularly described as follows: The S.E. 1/4 of N.W. 1/4 of S.W. 1/4, of Sec. 15 T. 10 S. R. 17 E. B. M. Also a strip of land beginning at the N.W. corner of said above described 10 Acres subdivision and running thence N. 37.1 Ft. thence E. at Right Angles to the Sec. line 663 Ft. to a point in the E. line of the N.W. 1/4 of S.W. 1/4 of said section 15 thence S. along E. line of said subdivision 44.8 Ft. thence W. along the N. boundary of the said S.E. 1/4 of N.W. 1/4 of S.W. 1/4 of said section to the place of beginning.  
The said Edwin W. Davis does further state that it is his intention to include the same and the whole thereof in the said plat of Elm Park Addition to the City of Twin Falls. And he does further hereby declare that in consideration of the filing of said plat by the County Recorder of Twin Falls County Idaho, and the acceptance by the public of the streets and alleys shown upon said plat he does hereby give and grant to the public forever in fee simple such portion of the premises platted as are on said plat set apart for streets, alleys and public places for public use forever.
