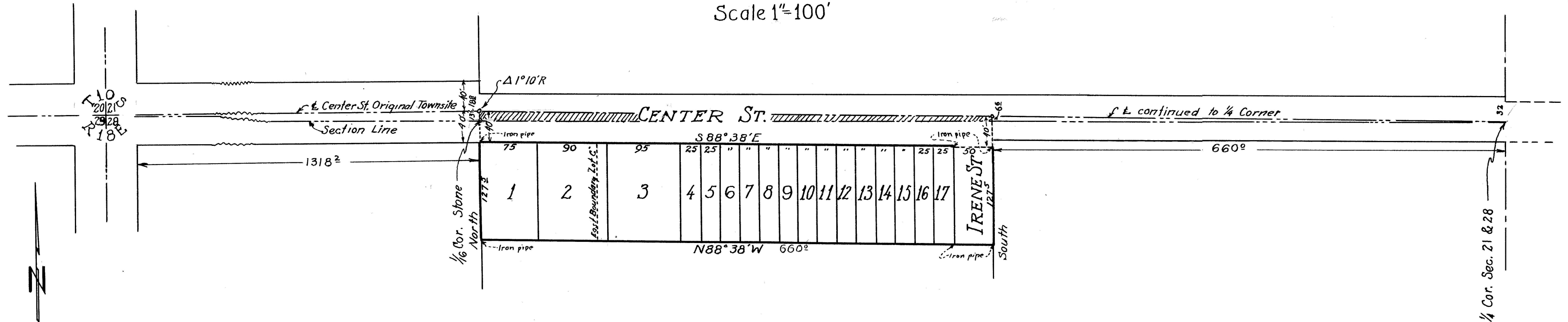


HAMILTON ADDITION KIMBERLY IDAHO

This is to certify that the undersigned are owners in fee simple of the property herein after described; that the correct description of the land included in this plat is as follows: Beginning at a point on the center line of Center Street as platted of the Revised Townsite of Kimberly, Idaho which point is 1318² feet east of the Northwest corner of Section 28 T10S, R18E.B.M.; thence, S88°38'E 660° along a line which joins the said point of beginning and the North Quarter Corner of said Sec. 28; thence, South 167⁵ feet; thence, N88°38'W 660°; thence, North 167⁵ feet to the point of beginning all within the NE⁴NW⁴ of said Sec. 28; excepting a parcel of land described as beginning at a point on the center line of Center Street 1318² feet east of the Northwest corner of said Sec. 28; thence, S88°38'E 660° feet; thence 6° feet South; thence, N89°23'W 660°; thence, North 13° feet to the point of beginning; that it is the intention of the undersigned to and they hereby include said land in this plat; that the undersigned, and each of them, do by these present grant, bargain, sell, convey, confirm and dedicate to the public for public use forever, all thoroughfares, streets, alleys and parks as shown on this plat: "Lot C" as designated on the Revised Plat of The Townsite of Kimberly Idaho is hereby subdivided into Lot 1 and part of Lot 2 on this plat.

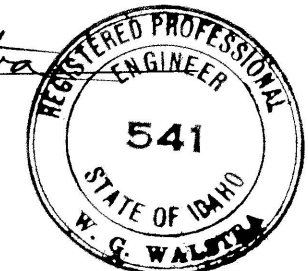
