Whereas, the original owners and proprietors of a certain parcel of land known as the Townsite of Kimberly and certain vacated portions thereof, in the county of Twin Falls, State of Idaho, more particularly described as follows, to-wit: - the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 20, the SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 21, the Northeast 650 ft. square of the NE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 29, and that parcel of land, beginning at a point 40 ft. south of the 1/4 corner between Sections 21 & 20, and on the East line of said townsite, thence easterly 150 ft., thence south 127.5', thence west 150 ft., thence north 127.5' to point of beginning, all of above describing being in T10S, R18E, B1N, as contemplated in Section 4087 Codified Laws of the State of Idaho, have sold or conveyed said land and invested the public with certain rights therein and have failed and neglected to execute and file for record a plat of said subdivisions as provided by said section 4087.
