On the 25th day of May 1914, before me a Notary Public for said county, personally appeared J.W. Craven, known to me to be the Secretary of the corporation that executed the attached instrument and acknowledged to me that such corporation exists and that the said J.W. Craven is its Secretary. WHEREFORE, I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my official seal the day and year in this certificate first above written.

Stone monuments are marked thus, "●", and are set at intersection of all streets as shown upon the accompanying plat.
