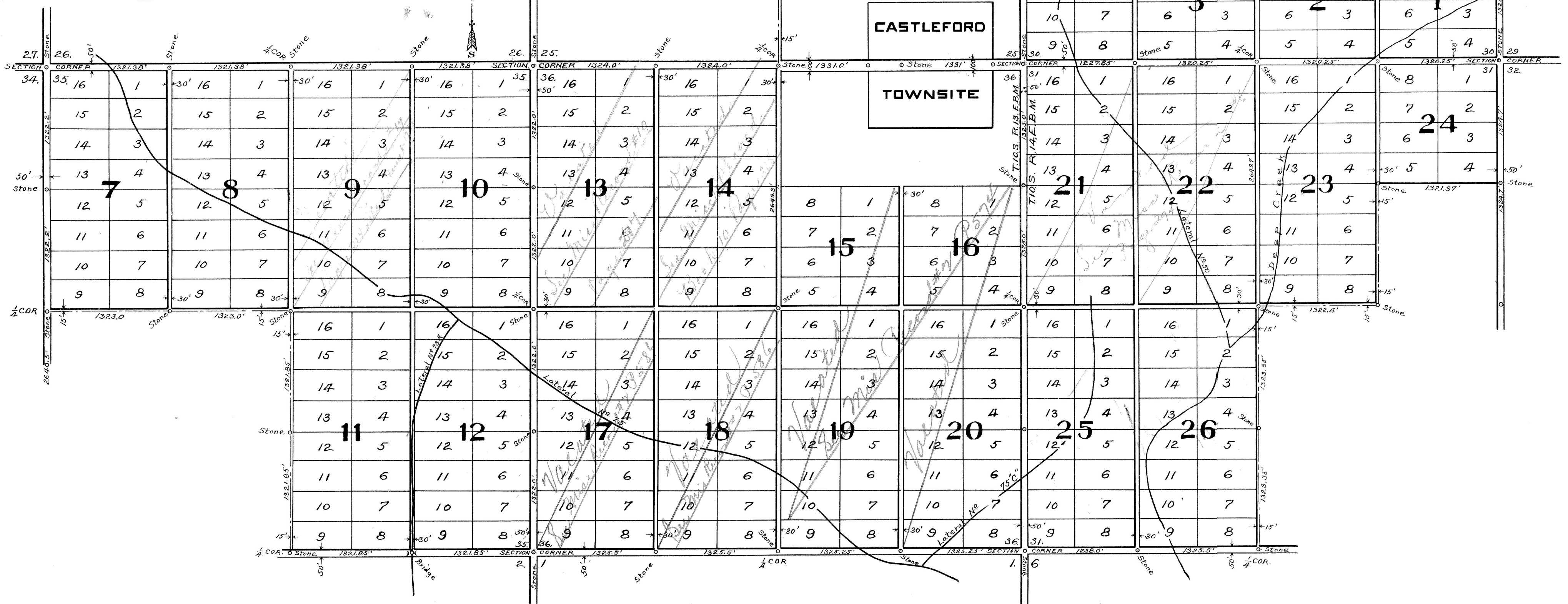

M.; also lots 3 and 4, and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 30; and lots 1, 2, 3 and 4, and the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$; the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$; and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 31, in Tp. 10 S., R. 14 E. B. M.

That all government section and quarter section corners upon the boundaries of the above described lands are in place, and that stone monuments have been placed by affiant at all minimum government subdivisions of said described land, and that the accompanying plat accurately represents the location of all such section quarter section, and minimum government subdivision corners as set upon the ground.
