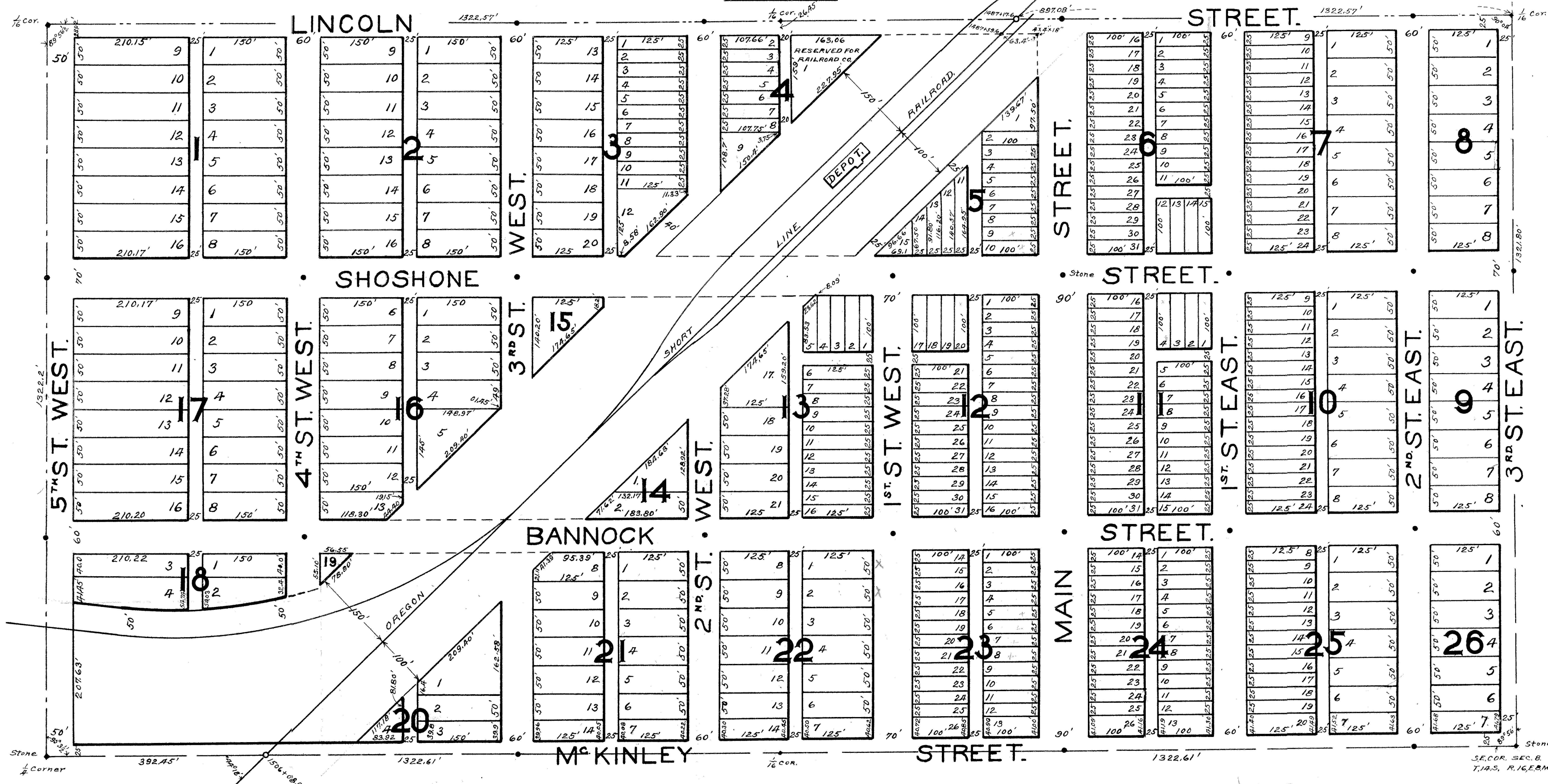


PLAT OF ROGERSON, IDAHO.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the Rogerson Townsite Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Idaho, by its Vice President F.B. Robinson, and Secretary, Robert Rogerson, does hereby certify that the following is a correct description of the land owned by the said Rogerson Townsite Company and included in the plat of Rogerson, Idaho, which is included herewith; said lands being known and described as the southwest one quarter of the southeast one quarter, and the southeast one quarter of the southeast one quarter of Section 8, T. 14 S. R. 16 E. B.M. Idaho. And said Corporation does further state that it is its intention to include the same and the whole thereof, except that which is dedicated to the Minn. and Southern Railroad Company, for purposes of right of way Idaho and Station grounds, in the plat of Rogerson, And it does further declare that in consideration of the filing of said plat by the County Recorder of Twin Falls County, Idaho, and the acceptance by the Public of the streets and alleys shown upon said plat it does hereby give and grant to the Public, forever, in fee simple, such portions of the premises platted, as are on said plat set apart for streets and alleys.
