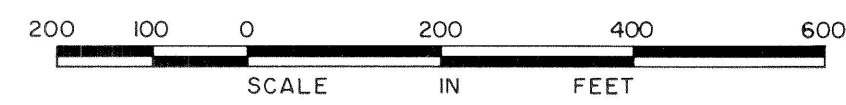


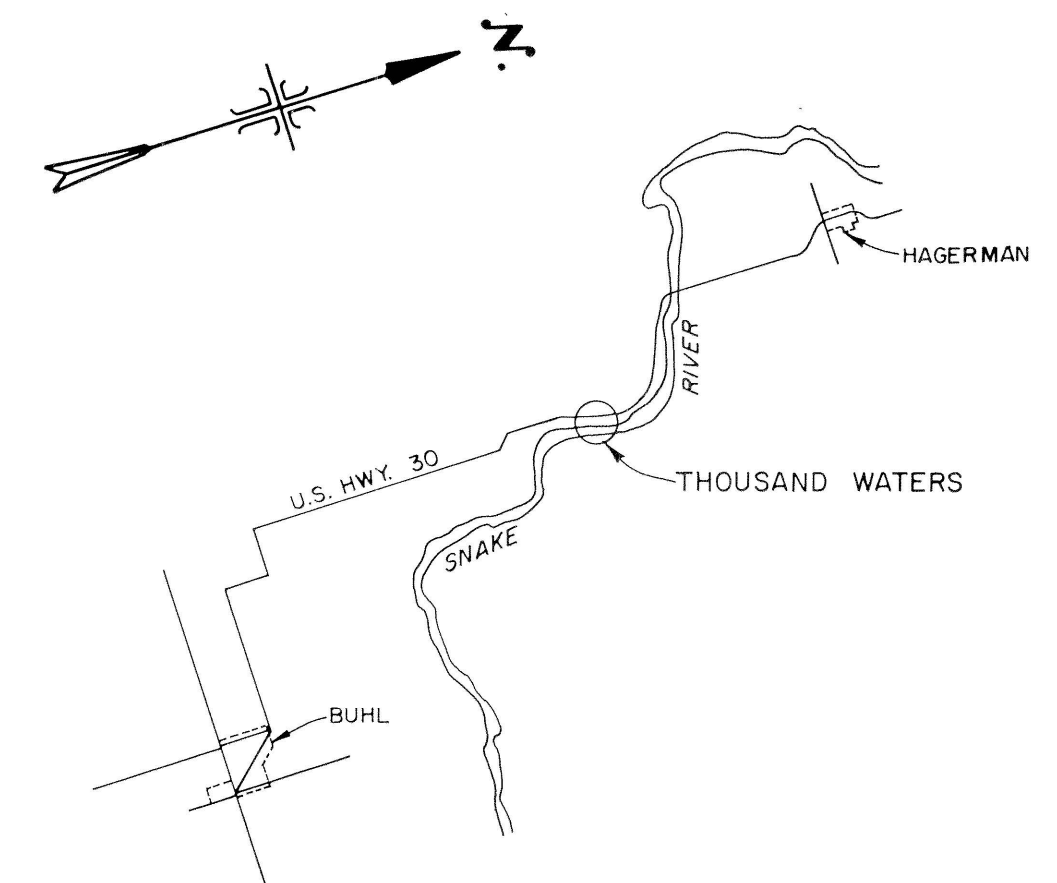
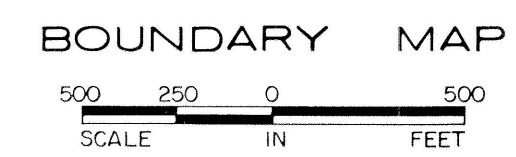
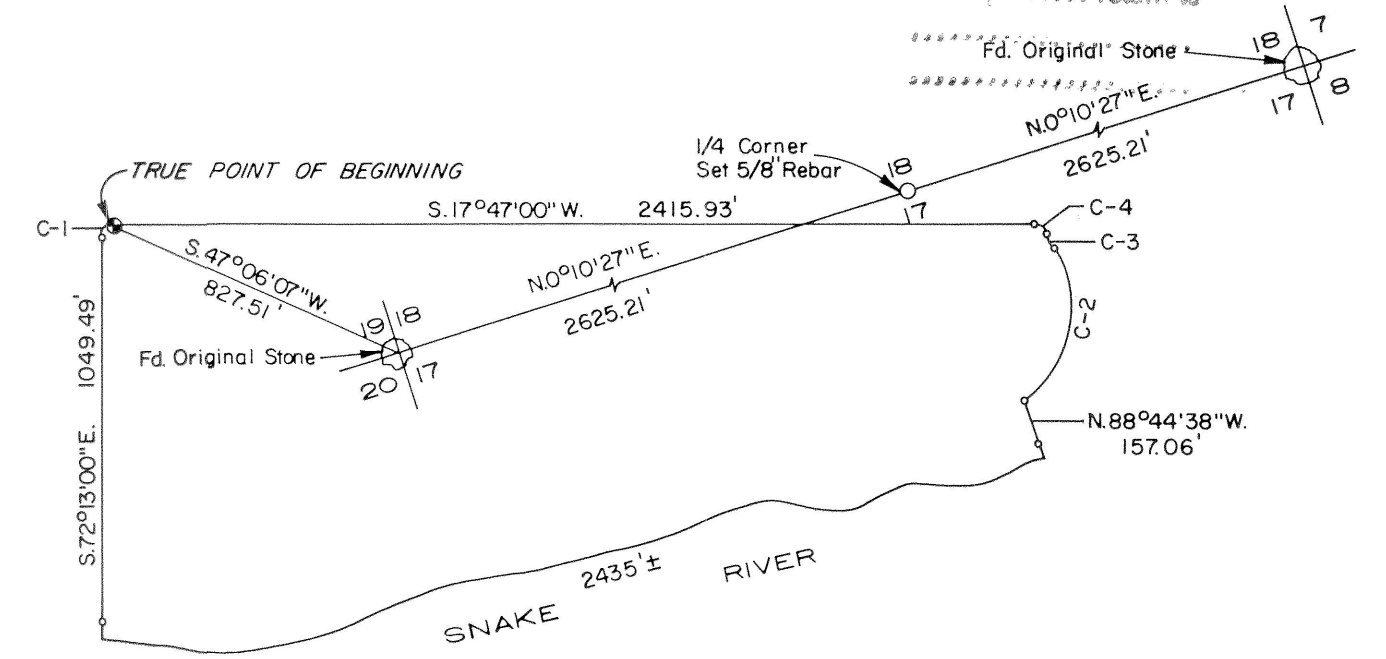
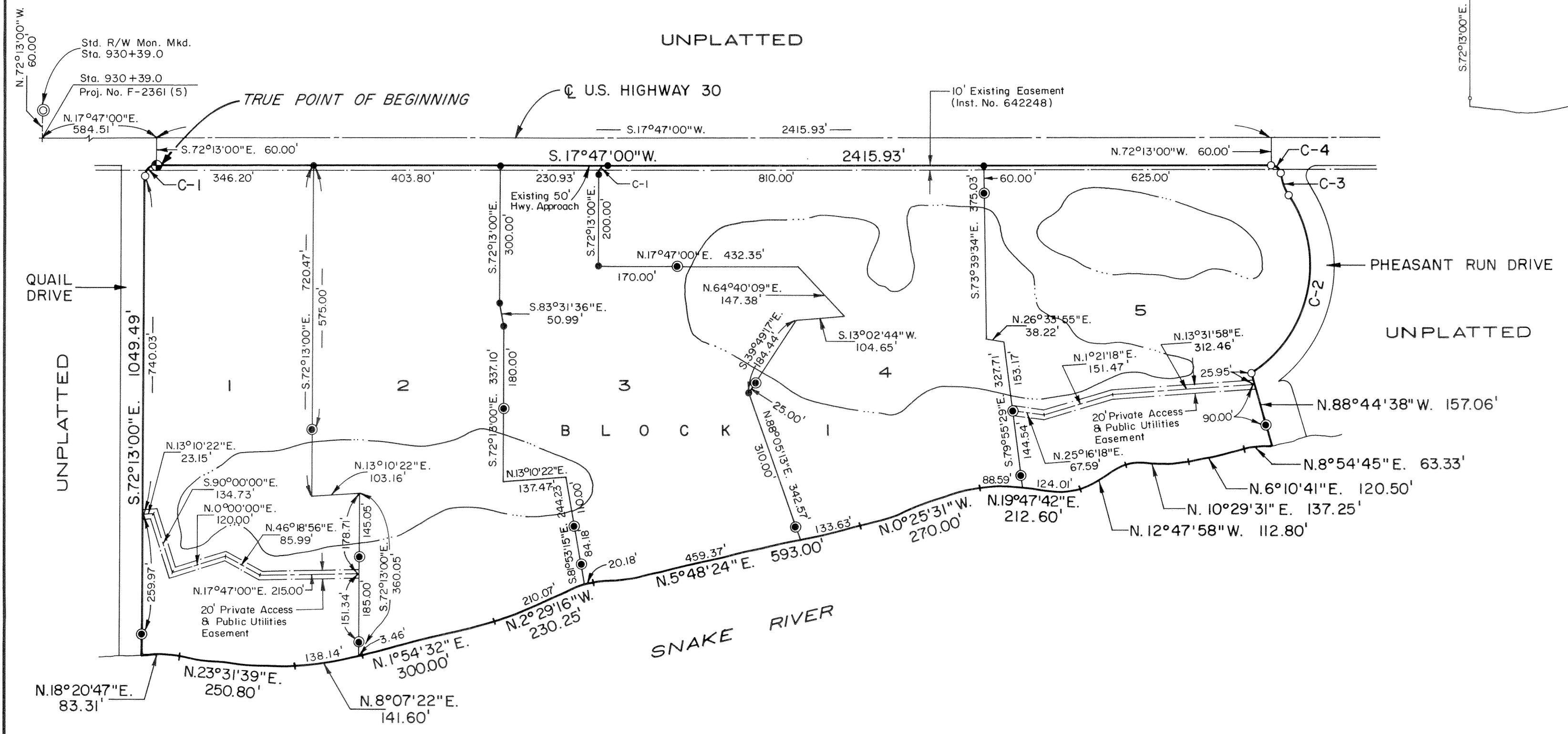
NOTES

1. There is hereby reserved along all lot frontages adjacent to streets, a 5' wide easement for public utilities.
2. The property line along the Snake River is the mean high water line. Mean high water line is the line found at the margin of the area occupied by the water for the greater portion of each average year.
3. Access rights along U.S. Hwy. 30 have been dedicated to the State of Idaho and are limited to the road connections as shown upon this plat.
4. There is hereby reserved a right of use easement that allows use of the total lake for only the lots that border that lake. This easement shall be applied to each lake individually.

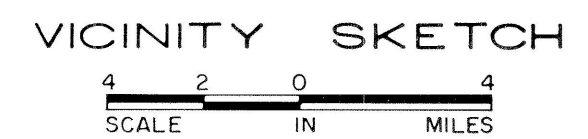
