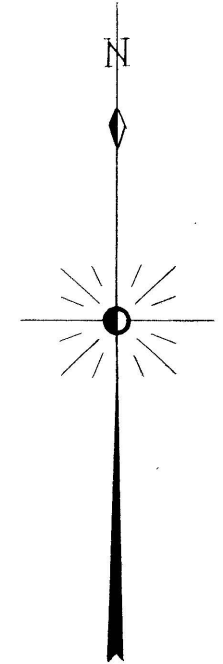


TWIN FALLS TOWNSITE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I

TWIN FALLS TOWNSITE CO. of SALT LAKE CITY, SALT LAKE COUNTY, UTAH, does hereby certify that the following is a correct description of the land included in the plat of Twin Falls which is included herewith, said lands being known and described as being a part of the 36th of Section 16 T 10 S, R 17 E, beginning at a point 545°23'E 475 ft. from the center of said Section 16 (the center being 3743 ft. from the NE corner) thence N44°37'E 355 ft. to a stone monument, thence 545°23'E 920 ft. to a stone monument, thence N44°37'E 1050 ft. to a stone monument, thence 545°23'E 920 ft. to a stone monument, thence N44°37'E 1750 ft. to a stone monument, thence N45°23'W 1850 ft. to a stone monument, thence N44°37'E to place of beginning.

And I do further state that it is the intention to include the same, and the whole thereof, in the said plat of Twin Falls. And I do further hereby declare that, in consideration of the filing of said plat by the County Recorder of Cassia County, Idaho, and the acceptance by the public of the streets and alleys shown up on said plat, I hereby give and grant to the public forever, in fee simple, such portions of the premises platted as is on said plat set apart for streets, alleys or other public use.

To have and to hold unto the public said streets, alleys and public places for public use forever.
